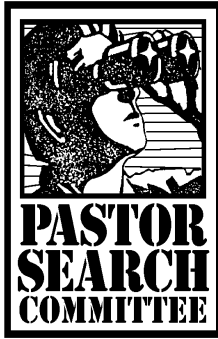


**FROM OUR
